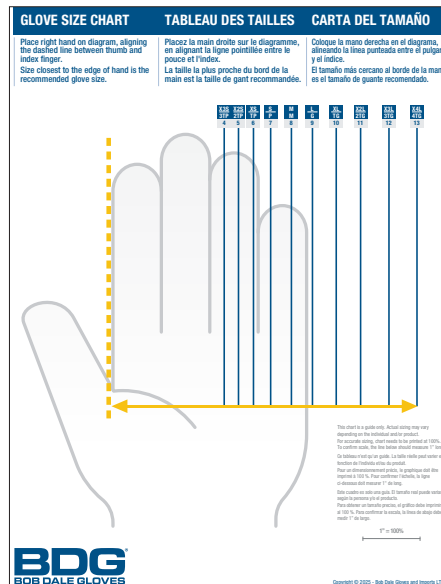




## CHECK YOUR FIT

- Your safety gloves should fit comfortably on the palm and all the way to your fingertips. If you have excess material at your fingertips try a smaller size.
- Wearing too small of a glove can lead to wearer discomfort and hand fatigue.
- The palm of your glove needs to fully cover your palm. If it doesn't, your gloves are too small and won't fully protect you.
- If the material on your glove's palm bunches up when you close your hand, your gloves are too big and can get caught up in tools or machinery and lead to an injury.
- A proper fitting glove should feel snug around your hands but still allow you dexterity to do the job. Too small of a glove can restrict movement and cut off circulation to your hands.

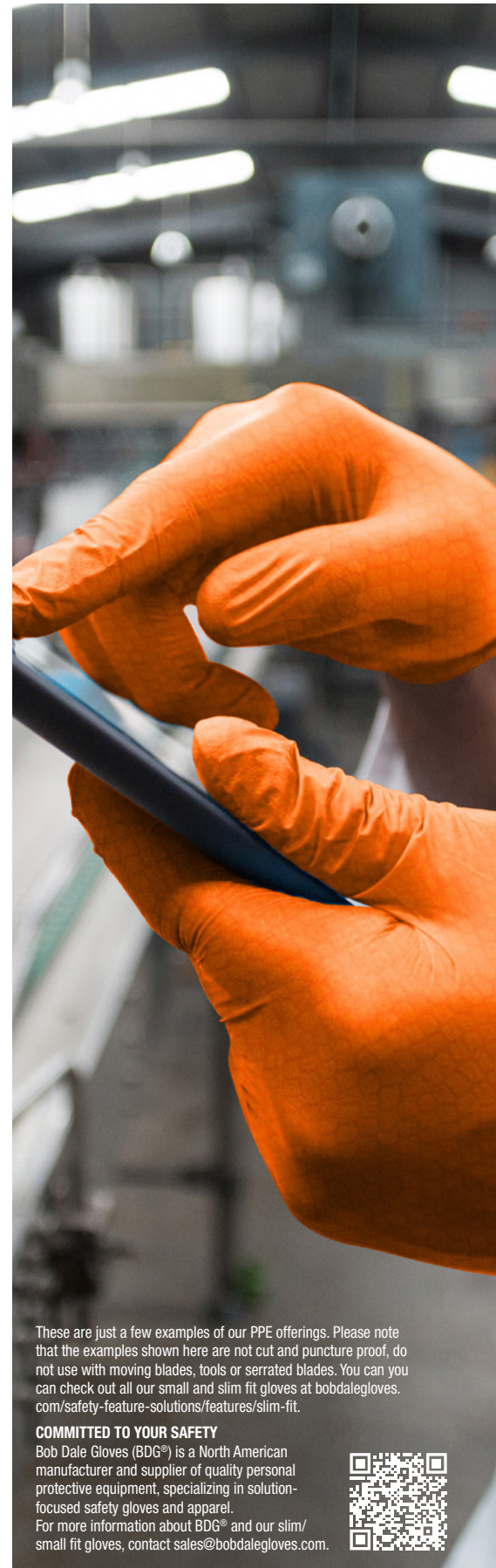
